The content deviated significantly from other intro Econ classes. What happened is that we would often learn the same content as other lectures but also learn content the professor admits is not "usually" a part of an intro Econ class. What happened, then, is that we would go over more material in the same amount of time as other intro Econ classes. Some lectures would cover content that neither is part of intro Econ nor did Professor Porter expect us to remember, so some lecture classes were "wasted" not helping us learn the material. The pace of the course was extremely difficult. The discussion, I found, rarely helped me understand the material. While somewhat interesting, I could not see the connection from the discussions to the lectures in a way that helped me understand the material for most of the discussions.
