The course was not overly difficult, however the class discussion and weekly problem sets were challenging enough to require me to pay full attention and give effort. The pacing of the class lectures was a good speed, neither too fast or too slow. The problem sets were applicable to what was being taught in class.
Strength: clear goals

The professor was quick to give feedback and always accessible. He posted course material and extra content on Moodle. I learned a lot that would be useful for Econ 300.
Assignments directly correlated to what we were doing in class, however, because it was a quarter class things often moved incredibly quickly and a dense amount of subjects was expected to be taught in a short amount of time.

Strength: nice explanations Weaknesses: sometimes too much explanations on the board (could be more concise)
Very enthusiastic, kinda went all over the place and seemed frazzled
The teaching was good as he made sure that we followed, always checking in on us throughout class when we covered new topics. He was respectful and always made sure we didn't have questions before moving on. The only weakness was not explaining something entirely before beginning it. I think that a background or an example of how it would be applied would greatly help the students in class.
The teaching is in depth but at times it seems that there are too many topics being displayed and not enough reinforcement of what has just been taught.
Very enthusiastic and cares about the knowledge of his students. No weaknesses
Sometimes unnecessary material that was quite difficult to understand were covered in lectures.
Professor Porter was incredibly patient with his students and made it his priority to make sure his students understood what was being taught to the absolute best of his ability. However, due to the constraints of the course the material often moved incredibly quickly and didn't allow for deeper mathematical understanding
The teacher was very nice and very helpful outside of class. He was a highlight of the class. I think he was not very clear a lot of the time. his teaching often felt all over the place which made it hard to stay engaged. But when questions were asked he answered them very efficiently. I think overall he is a great teacher but needs to work on clarifying things and concentrating on the important parts of the material.
The instructor had a lot of knowledge on the topic which made it easy to understand
Clear and enthusiastic. Weakness practice problems for tests were posted late (too close to the day of the test or exam).
He was a great teacher, he always asked if we had questions and gave concrete examples to aid teaching
Passionate and easy to understand.
While Professor Porter is extremely enthusiastic about the subject he is teaching, he lacks structure in his lectures. It is sometimes hard to follow what he's explaining due to his erratic writing and explanation of topics. If the Professor just slowed down and focused on teaching us how to apply the material he is teaching instead of giving 20 minutes of in-depth proofs of why basic concepts of math work, it would be a lot easier to digest.
Going into this class I had already taken ap stats (didn't at 4 or 5 on exam), so each class felt more like a review of material rather than learning something new. I did have to adjust to Professor Porter's teaching because he taught the class differently than how my ap stats teacher taught his class. The main differences I noticed was in the language and notation of the material. This was pretty easy to overcome though since it was presented well and with good examples and explanations. I would say the only weakness in the teaching is that I wish there were more problems that used real world scenarios rather than being given a formula. I also think this would help more when going into the problem sets since this was the first time or first few times seeing the material in class in actual problems
Prof. Porter moves too fast through the material and doesn't do a proper job of explaining all concepts.
Strengths: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Super open for meetings outside of class and good responding at emails – Writes everything he says on the board, so you can't miss much – Notes are useful
Weaknesses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Knowledge is hard to digest sometimes from how technical the language is – Ease us into the class with maybe doing a do now first 10 minutes? As soon as class starts we're currently doing notes and learning new material most days
Strengths: super passionate and fun teacher Weaknesses: Would have liked more straightforward formulas given to us

The only thing is that it felt like he rushed into the content and it felt difficult to write everything that he was on the board, but besides that, I thought he did a great job. He was accessible and always open to answering questions, providing examples, etc.

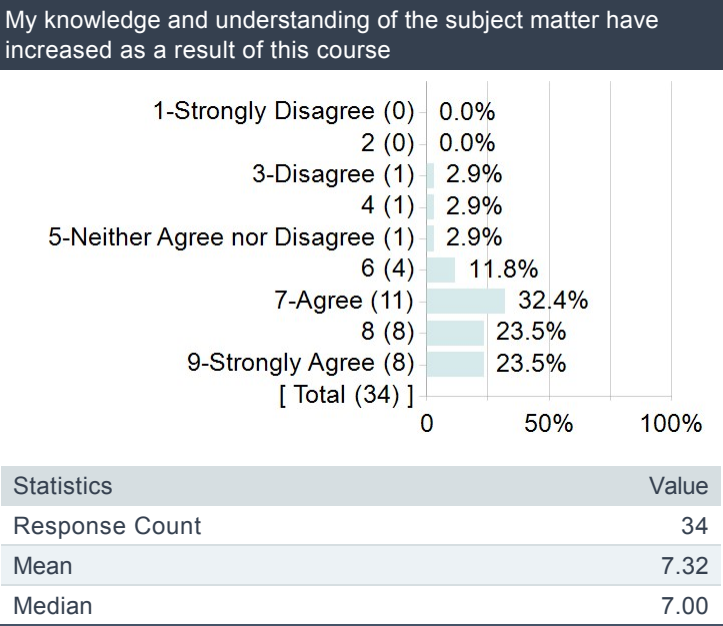
Comments

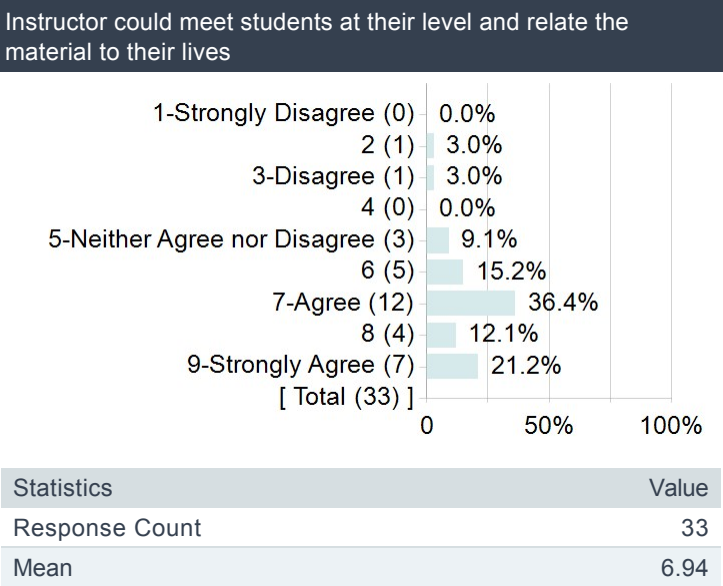

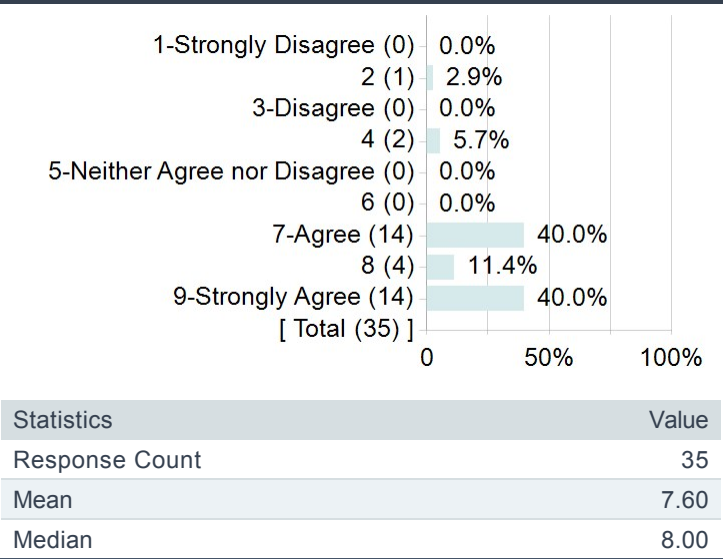


Instructor could meet students at their level and relate the material to their lives



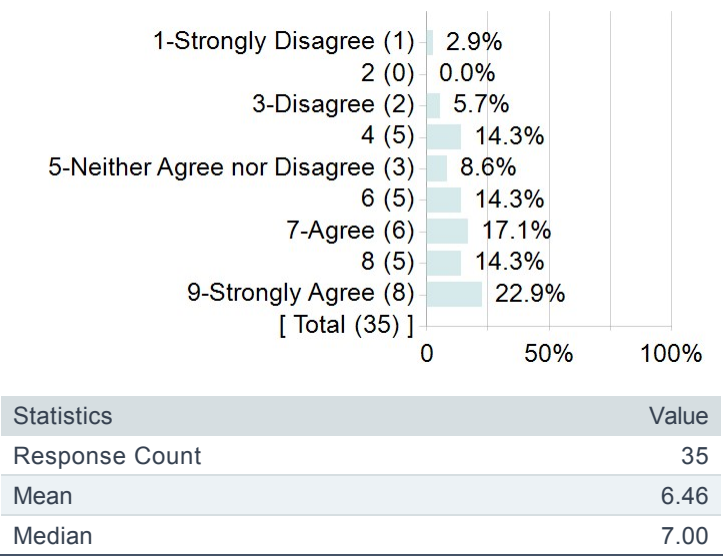
