Strengths —> I believe that this course did a great job of increasing my knowledge on statistics and that it's wasn't stressful at all. The workload was reasonable and with it being pass fail, I felt like I could just show up and learn as much as possible. Sometimes it's easier to worry just about the grade, but in ECON 103, if you try to obtain as much knowledge as possible, you will see an improvement from the beginning to the end of the course.


Comments
There were many times that the internet could teach me certain proofs and concepts better than the professor; I think that the teaching was confusing and overcomplicated the subject often: otherwise, the professor displayed enthusiasm and I never felt sleepy during class.
Strengths —> He does a great job of asking students if they understand the material when transitioning subjects and when we begin class. Sometimes when a student would ask a question, many other people also would have the same question and it was very useful to retain information. During some topics he would make us engage more than others, and I found those lessons the best ones because it made the class more interesting. Weaknesses —> Sometimes he would go too quick over certain topics that needed more time to be discussed and other times he would go too slowly on easier topics. A few of the lessons would also get repetitive and were boring to listen to, but otherwise his teaching was impactful.
Strengths— very open communication and is willing to help students Weakness— sometimes very confusing when teaching




What percentage of class sessions did you attend/view?




My knowledge and understanding of the subject matter have increased as a result of this course








