The lectures were very clear and the amount of work assigned felt manageable, but enough to boost my comprehension of the material. I really enjoyed the mini project because it was a chance to apply the curriculum to something I was passionate about.
Professor Porter was masterful in teaching the most amount of content he could in a small amount of time. Since this is only a 0.5 credit course that meets twice a week, we only had around ten classes the entire duration that the class was running, but I can truly say that I've learned a lot! If I was continuing to higher levels of ECON classes (ECON300, etc.), I would feel more than prepared for them. It accomplishes exactly what it sets out to do, laying fundamental groundwork in probability and statistics and then also suggests further avenues for deeper investigation into the subject (such as higher-level ECON classes, the statistics course in the math department, etc.).
The strength of this course was the pacing because the topics easily connected with each other and was easy to follow.
I think the course was fairly comprehensive and actually kind of fun.






On average, how many hours per week did you spend on coursework outside of class?




My knowledge and understanding of the subject matter have increased as a result of this course




### Instructor responded effectively when students voiced confusion or asked clarifying questions






