The course is structured in a good way, however some concepts we covered (like VBA) was not used for homework and I would have rather used that time to analyze more datasets to get ideas for the final project.
Strength: I appreciate that the lecture notes are posted with great detail (including screenshots so we know which button to click).
Weakness: sometimes I feel that the class is step by step of clicking things and I am not learning as much about how or why we are doing those steps.
Gave me a really good intro to Excel, I feel like I'll be able to work in a professional environment using excel.
The course was good at teaching what it covered. Even as an experienced Excel user, I had new material introduced to me. However, I wish there was a bit more emphasis on VBA and Python integrations. However, in order to achieve that, the course would have to be at least a semester long.
This was a unique class for me as I developed my Excel knowledge, which I have wanted to do for a very long time but had a difficult time obtaining in on the class due to its massive demand from students. Its load of work seemed very fair considering we met for a total of about 7 classes worth 21 hours, which is fair for a 0.5 credit course. The weaknesses of the class are the 3 hour long blocks which I struggle with as I tend to lose focus once a class passes the 1:30 mark it becomes very intense as well as it being at 7:10 pm –10:10 pm made it that much more difficult for me to focus considering I am an early sleeper. Overall, this is a class that I would recommend to others as it offers insight into useful tools that can be applied in any career.






On average, how many hours per week did you spend on coursework outside of class?








